date tbc | Bring along your old chess books, equipment, videos, DVDs and software for sale. All proceeds to club funds. Items will be priced to sell, so it's also your chance to pick up a bargain or two. |
| London League
Sept - April | The club enters teams in Divisions 3 and 4. All club members are eligible to play in the London League. We play 12 matches per season, mostly at our home venue, with one or two away matches. Matches start at 6.45pm and finish by 10pm. Team captains: Jim Robinson and Tom Fleming. |
| Civil Service League
Oct - March | The club enters two teams in the London Civil Service, Post Office and Municipal Chess League. Civil Service-qualified players and affiliate players are eligible for these teams. Matches are played home and away (within 6 miles of Charing Cross) and start at 6.30pm and finish by 9.30pm. Team captains: Derek Hadley and Paul Efstathiou. |
| Club Championship
Oct - May | The Bernfield and Foley/Ashelford Trophy competitions are organised in all-play-all graded sections and run in parallel with the league season. It is up to players to arrange their club championship games with their opponents. All games graded. Engraved trophies held for one year by the winners. Tournament controller: Jim Robinson. |
| Ladder Tournament
Oct - April | If you're unable to enter one of the club championship tournaments, or would like a few extra graded games, the club operate a ladder tournament throughout the season. New entries accepted up until 1 st March. Tournament organiser: Paul Efstathiou. |
| Christmas Tournament
Tuesday 22 December | A tournament for all members, at 19 th century-style odds. Special prizes in each round for achieving various chess feats along the way. Tournament organiser: Nigel Blades |
| Handicap Tournament
date tbc | A tournament for all members, played at a time handicap according to grade. |
